

HYMN OF THE MONTH...In January, we will sing hymn 403 - "O Savior of Our Fallen Race" translated by Gilbert E. Doan.

Gilbert E. Doan was educated at Harvard University (Bachelor of Arts 1942); Lutheran Theological Seminary (Bachelor of Divinity 1955); the University of Pennsylvania (Master of Arts 1962, though he returned it to the school to protest their policies); and Wagner College (Doctor of Divinity, late 1970s). He served as a campus pastor in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (1955-61); Northeastern Director of the National Lutheran Campus Ministry; and pastor of the Lutheran Church of the Holy Communion, Philadelphia (1984-95). His works include: The Preaching of Frederick W. Robertson (editor), 1964; Renewal in the Pulpit, 1966; Sermons on Peace and War; Preaching to College Students; Worship in Campus Ministry.


